Traffic Alert: Resurfacing of North Avenue Beginning Wednesday Morning

The City of Elmhurst has notified Elmhurst D205 that IDOT will begin paving the final surface of North Avenue, beginning this Wednesday morning at 4:00 am. The project will begin at the west end with the goal of completing all eastbound lanes by the end of the day. Crews will use two paving machines and all traffic will be one lane in each direction on the westbound lanes. Major delays are expected. The plan would then be to switch to paving the westbound lanes on Thursday, resulting in similar delays. Please allow extra time for commuting to school and work.
