Board Amends Comment Procedures

Beginning at the December 14, 2021 Board of Education meeting, the Board updated its public comment procedure. Sign-up for public comment will begin at 6:30 p.m. for Board meetings and 5:00 p.m. for Committee meetings. Speakers will now be called by number using a random number generator application to determine the order of the public comment speakers. The changes create clear and consistent procedures for our entire community. Board Meetings continue to be live-streamed for viewing on the District's website.

Ribbon Cutting

Elmhurst School District 205 and City of Elmhurst officials held a ribbon cutting December 16, celebrating the installation of a stormwater detention basin and an artificial turf field at York High School.

The project is the culmination of an intergovernmental agreement between District 205 and the City.

"Almost three years ago we made it a priority to work together to make this a reality," said District 205 Board of Education President Kara Caforio. "The signing of the Intergovernmental Agreement in 2019 represented the best of what Elmhurst is: Working together to wisely steward our resources in order to solve problems for our entire community," she said.

The stormwater vaults under the field built by the city address longtime flooding issues in the community and the full size soccer/lacrosse field offers additional usable space for our students and community members. Read more <u>here</u>.
