School Board Update (Karen Stuefen)

Superintendent Update (Dr. David Moyer)

Thanked the Council and individual PTA's for their support of the referendum. Next steps:

December 11th special board meeting- architect and construction manager will layout timelines and the work to be done between now and the start of the next school year. There will be many opportunities for community involvement and site specific involvement. Bond money will be needed to pay for architectural costs. Timeline will be presented next week.
