5Essentials Survey (Haga clic aquí para leer en español)

This winter, students, teachers and parents across Illinois will participate in the annual Illinois 5Essentials Survey. The survey will be administered online by the University of Chicago on behalf of the Illinois State Board of Education.

This survey will allow you and your child (in grades 4 through 12) to share thoughts on important elements of school effectiveness at your child's

school. Reports will be sent to schools and districts in June 2022 and data will also be included in the Illinois State School Report Card.

The parent survey opens on January 11th. To take the parent survey, please visit https://survey.5-essentials.org/Illinois/ and select the appropriate survey to begin. You will need to enter the county (DuPage) and school name. We need at least a 20 percent response rate to receive a report.

Your student will take the survey between January and March in grades 4 through 12. Details will be provided by each school. Under the Protection of Pupil Rights Act 20 U.S.C. Section 1232(c) (1) (A), you have the right to review a **copy of the questions** on the student survey. If you do not want your son or daughter to participate in the survey, download and fill out a **non-participation form** and return it to your child's school. Please be aware that student participation rates are one measure that the state uses in its **accountability system** for our schools.

Illinois Rental Repayment Program

The <u>Illinois Rental Payment Program</u> provides financial assistance for rent to income-eligible Illinois renters and their landlords who have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Illinois renters may be eligible for up to \$25,000 and 18 months of emergency rental payments under the program. This is a grant that does NOT have to be repaid.
