Dear D205 Families,

Thank you for a successful start to the 2019-20 school year. The first trimester/semester is fully underway and soon your child's grades will be accessible at the end of the term. This year, District 205 has added a new symbol to its standards-based reporting tool legend/key (Grades K-6) in an effort to help parents better understand how students are performing in each class relative to the standards.

The new symbol, an asterisk, will appear next to any class in which a student is receiving a modification. Modifications are individualized changes made to the content and assessment that results in the alteration of the standard or the learning outcome. Any alternate curriculum aligned to standards that is significantly **below** or **above** grade level should be considered a modification. A modification is not a temporary intervention or temporary use of a replacement curriculum.

If you have any questions about a report card, including the new modification symbol, please reach out to your child's teacher for clarity. Again, thank you for supporting the success of our students.
